We thank our siblings around the world for your prayers and words of support during this time of uncertainty and fear. As we look toward the coming days, we pray for all those impacted by war, death, and destruction. We lift our eyes to the one who brings comfort, peace, and justice to the world, our Lord Jesus Christ. Even as the ground shakes beneath our feet, we keep our trust in Him.

May God bring an end to this violence, and may we work for true peace throughout our homeland and the whole Middle East.
